HOW TO GET A LIBRARY CARD

Go to our online catalog and click on "Don't have a PWPLS library card?" to start your application to get a library card. Or you can show your Identification with your current address at your local library to apply for a library card. If you do not have identification with a current address, a card can be issued and you can check out three items. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent/guardian's signature to obtain a card.

HOW TO GET A DIGITAL LIBRARY CARD

Prince William County residents can access all of the library's digital services without visiting a library branch by signing up for a Digital Library Card. The Digital Library Cards expires in two years. To sign up, click here to select "Don't have a PWPLS library card?" to register for a Digital Library card.
